By accepting a Building/Structure, or Equipment Moving Permit, the permittee agrees to pay any claims for personal injury or property damage which may occur in connection with operations under the permit, and in the event any claim is made against the County of Le Sueur, or any department, officer, or employee thereof, through, by reason of, or in connection with any act or omission, the permittee shall defend, indemnify and hold them and each of them harmless for any claim(s).
2. By accepting a Building/Structure, or Equipment Moving Permit, the permittee agrees to repair at his own expense and to the satisfaction of the County Engineer any damage to highway or structures which may occur in connection with operations under this permit.
3. To insure the above, the permittee shall have a valid policy of liability insurance or bond affording substantially the same coverage with respect to injury to persons and damage to property as is required for proof on financial responsibility under the safety responsibility act.
