



Local Homeless Prevention Aid

Local Homeless Prevention Aid was created by the 2021 Minnesota Legislature to help governments ensure no child is homeless within a local jurisdiction by keeping families from losing housing and helping those experiencing homelessness find housing. Le Sueur County Human Services has designed a program with these funds where if you are facing eviction, or at risk of eviction, this aid can potentially assist you with housing expenses to obtain housing, or maintain your current housing. Families with children are given priority and must be within income guidelines to be eligible.

Eligibility Overview:

- CURRENT Le Sueur County Resident
- Loss or reduction of income (explanation will need to be provided)
- Eviction, foreclosure, utility shut-off or other housing need.
- Proof of sustainability of housing after utilizing assistance.
