

Le Sueur County invites you to attend a public open house meeting for the **CSAH 15 Reconstruction Project**. The upcoming open house is an opportunity to learn more about the project background, proposed roadway improvements, project schedule, project staging, overhead transmission line replacement and more.

No formal presentation is planned. Feel free to stop by at any time during the open house.

The project is proposed to include CSAH 15 (271st Ave) from CSAH 16 (490th St) to CSAH 18 (Dog Creek Road). The project is needed to complete the following:

- reconstruct failing pavement
- widen shoulders
- add turn lanes
- improve alignment near the lakes area.
- replace drainage facilities

Landowners with knowledge of existing agricultural field tile systems near or crossing the project limits are encouraged to provide any available maps, sketches, or documentation. This information will help the design team ensure that drainage features are properly identified and incorporated into the project.

The project is being coordinated with Great River Energy who is replacing the overhead transmission line throughout the corridor. Representatives from Great River Energy will be present at the open house to answer questions.
